My research is broadly inter-disciplinary and focuses on understanding language, its evolution and diversity, and the processes that affect them. I use a wide range of methods and sources of data, primarily statistics and data science applied to large computer-readable databases, computer modelling, and experimental approaches to inter-individual and cross-cultural variation. My education covers mathematics, computer science, psychology, neurobiology, evolution, and the language sciences. After switching from a career in the software industry (1997-2004) to a PhD in linguistics (2004-2007) and a career in academia, I held various post-docotoral positions (most funded through grants) at prestigious institutions in the UK (The University of Edinburgh, 2007-2008), the Netherlands (The Max Planck Institute for Psycholinguistics, 2008-2017) and France (Université de Lyon/Laboratoire Dynamique du Langage, 2017-2021). Since October 2021, I am an ICREA (Catalan Institution for Research and Advanced Studies) Research Professor at the University of Barcelona (Spain) in the Department of Catalan Philology and General Linguistics.
