

Freelance part-time job opportunity for speakers of Catalan

We are looking for native speakers of **Catalan** to help us localise our product.

what3words is a global addressing company that has given every 3m square on the planet an address of 3 random words – for example, our London office is located at [///filled.count.soap](https://filled.count.soap). what3words addresses are more accurate than street addresses or postcodes, but much easier to remember and communicate than 16 digit lat-long coordinates. We are currently working to launch a **Catalan** version of our map, so that every 3m square across the globe will have a unique what3words address in your language. The job focuses on two main areas:

- 1) making sure that the **best**, most **common** words in your language are used, and
- 2) making sure that **no unsuitable** words appear in the what3words addresses.

No specific qualifications are required, although you must be a native speaker of the language and be confident in your writing and spelling skills! It is helpful if you are passionate about language and/or technology, and you must be able to communicate confidently in English.

When applying, tell us **what you think of what3words**, including an example of when you think it may be useful for you. You will also be asked to upload a copy of your CV.

Work: Freelance from home (computer and internet access needed).

Compensation & Duration: there will be around 4 hours of training to undertake in October, for which the remuneration is a flat rate of 55 EUR total (or local equivalent). If successful with the training, you will be offered further work for around 3 months. This is on a part-time basis, around 5-10 hours a week. The remuneration for this further work is 14 EUR per hour (or local equivalent).

The deadline for applying to the role is **Wednesday 29th September**, and successful candidates will start the project on **Monday 11th October**.
